### What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help the site work properly and give us anonymous information about how people use our pages so we can make them better.

### How we use cookies

On the Cultivate website we use:

- Essential cookies – these keep the site secure and make basic features work (for example, remembering your cookie choices, keeping forms working).
- Analytics cookies – these help us understand which pages are visited, how long people stay and what is useful, so we can improve the site. We use this information in an aggregated, anonymous way.
- Third-party cookies – some tools we use (for example, videos, maps or social media links) may place their own cookies when you view or click them.

We do not use cookies to sell your data.

### Your choices

When you first visit our site, you'll see a cookie banner. You can:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies
- Manage your settings at any time

If you prefer, you can also block or delete cookies in your browser settings, though some parts of the site may not work as expected.
